If any other plant residue is used as packaging material, the consignment must be accompanied by a certificate stating: All pests and pest propagules have been killed before use of the material either by heating to 180° F/83°C, for ten minutes or by chemical treatment. (N.B:- Details to be stated on phytosanitary certificate). - Plant materials/ Plant product should not be genetically modified.
