CONDITIONS IMPORTANT - Importers should ensure that if the conditions below are not strictly observed, delivery of the plant matter listed in this permit may be refused. (a) The imported plant matter must be free from any pest and must be found to be free from any evidence of disease or insect infestation of any kind, and from soil, sediments, stones, and other debris, not listed in the permit. (b) The importation must be accompanied by original Phytosanitary Certificate issued by a recognised agricultural or biosecurity authority of the country in which the plants were grown, which shall certify: (i) that the plants are believed to be free from all forms of disease or insect infestation. (c) The importation must be packed in clean new polyethylene bags not previously used for any purpose and must not be packed in hay, straw, shells etc. for any accompanying material. (d) Any non-compliance of the above conditions will result in the revocation of the import permit and destruction of the imported plant product and any other actions taken as directed by the Executive Chairman/CDO Biosecurity Authority of Fiji and all as the importer's expenses.					
All of the above conditions must be strictly observed except those deleted and initialed by the issuing officer.
